



WHEREAS, The Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. was founded on the 17th of November 1911 on the campus of Howard University in Washington, D.C., by three undergraduate students, with the assistance of their faculty advisor; and

WHEREAS, from the initials of the Greek phrase meaning "friendship is essential to the soul," the name Omega Psi Phi was derived, and the phrase was selected as the motto, manhood, scholarship, perseverance, and uplift were adopted as cardinal principles; and

WHEREAS, in the State of Kansas, Delta Phi Chapter was established on the 14th of May 1925 on the campus of Washburn University and has been an intricate part of the Topeka community by providing uplift and fulfilment of the fraternity's nationally mandated programs for the past 100 years; and

WHEREAS, this organization, known as the "Top City Ques" has volunteered countless man-hours and donated thousands of dollars to multiple projects to uplift and encourage citizens in this city to achieve higher social, economic, and intellectual statuses; and

WHEREAS, The Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. continues to occupy a progressive, cooperative, and constructive place in the civic and political life of the communities, nation, and world, and its members are pillars of their communities in all walks of life, this including their involvement with the 1954 Brown v. Board of Education campaign and countless other movements which impacted the collective good of all people.
